### **Information regarding lowering of cut off marks by Govt. of India Ministry of Health and Family Welfare and opening of Registration (MD/MS/Diploma)**

This is for information to all the aspiring candidates who wish to participate in the M.P. State combined P.G. counseling ( MD/MS/Diploma) NEET P.G.2020 , that as per Govt. of India Ministry of Health and Family Welfare letter dated F.No.V.11012/15/2020-MEP dated 14th July 2020, the qualifying cut off percentile for all categories has been lowered for candidates of NEET PG 2020 Qualifying cut off marks for different categories are- UR/EWS -275 , UR/EWS – PWD 252 and SC/ST/OBC (Including PWD) -230 (As per National Board Of Examination letter dated 14<sup>th</sup> July).

Online registration for eligible candidates as per revised qualifying criteria will open from 15-07-2020 (05:00 PM) to 17/07/20 (12:00 Midnight) on MPOnline DME Portal ([dme.mponline.gov.in](http://dme.mponline.gov.in)). Willing candidates may register themselves within mentioned time frame to participate in the remaining counseling.

**Attention: All NEET- PG 2020 Candidates**

1. The result of NEET-PG 2020 was declared by NBE on 30<sup>th</sup> January 2020. In accordance with Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of India letter F.No.V.11012/15/2020-MEP dated 14<sup>th</sup> July 2020, the minimum qualifying percentiles have been lowered as follows:
