Instructions to Second round of counselling

First round of allotment for various courses in Arts and Science (Group IV) was done for 4944 seats and candidates were given the following options through the dashboard.

Option 1 : Accept the allotment(Confirmed and do not participate in subsequent rounds)

Option 2: Waiting (Accept the first allotment and join the allotted college. But, the candidate is willing to be considered in the second round for better course preference)

Option 3: Not Accepted (Candidate discards the allotment, not willing to join the college but willing to be considered in the second round for better course preference.)

Option 4: Reject (Candidate discards the allotment, not willing to join the college and opt to be out of subsequent rounds of counseling)

Upon closing the admission on 3rd August, 2018, about 2400 seats remain vacant for which the CENTAC is preparing for second round of allotment. Following is the procedure for considering the candidates to be included in the second round.

Applicants Chosen option 1 will not be considered for inclusion in the second round. However, the candidates whose allotment order were rejected at the allotted colleges will be considered eligible for inclusion in second round of allotment.

Applicants chosen option 2 will be considered for inclusion in the second round subject to the following conditions:

- Candidate will forego the seat allotted in the first round if he/she gets a course of his/her preference in the second round of allotment. The seat will be considered released and given to other wait listed candidates based on merit.
- If he/she gets a course of his/her preference in the same college, the fee will be adjusted and candidate admitted in the course allotted in the second round.
- If he/she gets a course of his/her preference in some other college, the college in which he/she has been admitted in first round will return all the original certificates after cancelling the admission and the fee reimbursed as per the norms of the college.
- **Under no circumstances, the candidate can opt to hold the seat.**
- To avoid cancellation of the existing seat, the candidates are advised to prioritize the course preference in such a way that the last course in the preference list is same as the one that he/she holds in the first allotment.

- **Illustration:** Suppose a candidate was allotted B.A. English in TAC and got admitted after choosing Option 2. Now she can prioritize her course preferences as depicted below.

1. B.Com in BGCW
2. B.A. English in BGCW
3. B.A. Tamil in BGCW
4. B.A. English in TAC

Note in this illustration that the candidate's last preferred course is same as the one that she has been allotted in the first round. This candidate if allotted B.A. English in BGCW (say for example), will be given all the original certificates by TAC after canceling the admission and the fee reimbursed as per the norms of the college. This candidate can never opt to hold her seat in TAC because her seat would have been allotted to another wait listed candidate in the second round of allotment.

Applicants chosen option 3

The candidates are free to choose and prioritize the course of their choice.

Applicants chosen option 4

Such candidates will not be considered in any more rounds of course allotment. Their candidature will be removed from the merit list.

Applicants chosen none of the four options

Candidates who were allotted seat in first round of counseling, but never logged-in to the dashboard for choosing one of the four options will be considered **NOT ELIGIBLE** to be included in the second round of course allotment.
